

# VERUS<sup>®</sup> PRO **Code Scan with Report** (scan/view/print)

Selecting Code Scan starts an active scan of vehicle control modules. The scan results are configured into a printable Code Scan Report.

# Use Code Scan to Scan Systems<sup>1</sup>

Once you have connected and identified a vehicle through Scanner, select Code Scan (Figure 1) from the Vehicle System menu to start an active scan of vehicle control modules.

# View Code Scan Results

The total number of systems analyzed is actively displayed at the top of the screen (Figure 2).

# **Customizing Report Output**

To personalize the shop information included on the Code Scan Report:

- 1. From the Home screen select System Settings.
- 2. From the System Settings menu select Shop Information.
- 3. Enter your information in the form fields (*Figure 5*), then select **OK** from the toolbar to confirm the setting.

To hide/show the timestamp (time of day) on the Code Scan Report:

- 1. From the Home screen select System Settings.
- 2. From the System Settings menu select Shop Information.
- Select the On/Off checkbox (*Figure 6*), then select OK from the toolbar to confirm the setting.

## **Before You Print**

Before you can print the Code Scan Report you must install a printer, see *Printer Setup*.

# Printing (From Code Scan Screen)

After a code scan has been performed, the Code Scan Report can be directly printed by selecting the **Print** icon from the toolbar (*Figure 7*).

When print is selected, the file (Figure 8) is sent directly to the default printer.

### **Printer Setup**

To print the Code Scan Report, a printer must installed and set as the system default printer.

The following is intended as a basic printer setup instruction only. Printer setup will vary. For specific instructions and details, refer to your printer setup information and the online Windows printer setup help information.

### **USB Printer Setup**

- Turn the printer on. 1.
- 2. Connect the USB cable from the printer to the diagnostic tool.
- 3. Windows should automatically detect and install the printer.
- Follow the onscreen instructions (Figure 9) to install the printer and then 4 set the printer as the default printer, see Default Printer Setting.

Note: If the printer driver files are not automatically installed, you will have to manually install the printer driver files. Printer driver files may be supplied with the printer (e.g. CD or memory stick), or check the printer manufacturer's website to download the files. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for driver installation.

### Add Printer Wizard (network printer connection)

Use this procedure if you not directly connecting the printer with a USB cable to the diagnostic tool.

- Turn the printer on. 1.
- 2. Select Start from the Windows desktop.
- 3. Select Printers and Faxes (Figure 10) from the systems menu.
- 4. Select Add Printer (Figure 11). The Add Printer Wizard opens.
- Follow the onscreen instructions to install the printer and then set the 5. printer as the default printer. See Default Printer Setting.

Note: If the printer driver files are not automatically installed, you will have to manually install the printer driver files. Printer driver files may be supplied with the printer (e.g. CD or memory stick), or check the printer manufacturer's website to download the files. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for driver installation.

### **Default Printer Setting**

To set a default system printer:

- Select Start from the Windows desktop. 1.
- Select Printers and Faxes (Figure 10) from the systems menu (right 2. side).
- 3. Select (double-click) the printer you want to set as the default printer from the list of installed printers (Figure 12).

The printer status window opens.

- Select Printer from the toolbar menu. 4.
- 5. From the menu, select "Set as default printer" (Figure 12). When set, a check mark is displayed next to the option.
- Close the printer status window. 6.
