

Business Bank Account Information/Requirements

Your business bank account is <u>required</u> to be in your name.

Below are examples of what should show on the actual checks:

- [Name of the Franchisee], Authorized Franchisee for Snap-on Tools
- [Name of Franchisee's Corporation or Limited Liability Company LLC)]
- [Name of Franchisee (Joe Smith d/b/a Smith's Tools)]
- ➤ The use of "D/B/A Snap-on Tools" or "Doing Business as Snap-on Tools" is <u>not</u> <u>permitted</u> on your business bank account or checks.
- All checks written are required to be made on your business bank account, including payments to Snap-on, Snap-on Credit, EC collections, weekly tool bill payments, van lease, time payments, and miscellaneous operating expenses, including cash withdrawals to pay for gasoline or any other daily business expenses.
- When visiting your banking institution to establish your business bank account, advise them that you wish to set up a personal account for your business if you are not forming a corporation or limited liability corporation.
